

**The County of Dorset (Various Roads, Winterborne Whitechurch)  
(20mph Speed Limit) (No. 5) Order 2026**

Dorset Council in exercise of powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of the Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. "The County of Dorset (Restricted Roads) (No 1) Order 1987 (Various Roads, Winterborne Whitechurch)" is hereby revoked in so far as it as it relates to the sections and lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. "The County of Dorset (Whatcombe Lane, Winterborne Whitechurch) (Restricted Roads) (No 11) Order 1994" is hereby revoked in so far as it as it relates to the sections and lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. This Order may be cited as "The County of Dorset (Winterborne Whitechurch) (20mph Speed Limit) (No. 5) Order 2026" and shall come into operation on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April 2026.

Castle Green	For its entire length
Chescombe Lane	From its junction with Milton End in a westerly direction, for approximately 320 metres
Dolway Lane	From its junction with Milton End in a northerly direction for approximately 117 metres
Fields Close	For its entire length
Fosters Meadows	For its entire length
Milton End	For its entire length
Old Oak Way	For its entire length
St Mary's Close	For its entire length
Whatcombe Lane	From its junction with A354 Dorchester Hill in a northerly direction for approximately 272 metres
